Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:**
 - Helps students build **categorization skills** by spotting the item that does not fit a group.
 - Encourages early critical thinking and vocabulary awareness.
- **Before the activity:**
 - Review the idea of groups such as **animals, foods, colors, places, and actions**.
 - Model one example on the board and explain why one word does not belong.
- **During the activity (differentiation and support):**
 - Read the word sets aloud for emerging readers and discuss each group briefly.
 - Let students underline or circle the three words that go together before choosing the one that is different.
 - Provide picture cues for students who benefit from visual support.
 - Challenge advanced students to explain each answer in a complete sentence.
