Teacher's Guide

- Skill focus: **SAT-style logical sentence completion** using tone, contrast, and cause-effect clues.
- Time: 10 to 15 minutes; fits one page.
- What to emphasize:
 - Students should eliminate choices that break logic before selecting the best fit.
 - Encourage attention to contrast words like although, however, despite.
- Differentiation:
 - Support: Have students underline the key logical hinge in each sentence.
 - Challenge: Ask students to explain why one incorrect option is tempting but wrong.
- Engagement:
 - Pair reasoning: Students defend their answers aloud using sentence logic only.
- Extension:
 - Test transfer: Students write one original SAT-style sentence with four options and trade with a partner for completion.
