Crow's Lesson Answer Key

Correct Moral:

A. It is better to share than to boast.

Extension Question (sample answers may vary):

- The crow could have kept quiet and eaten his bread.
- The crow could have shared instead of bragging.

Teacher Notes:

- A **theme** is the big idea or lesson a story teaches. In fables, this is often called a **moral**.
- Encourage students to notice the crow's greed and pride led to his problem.
- Remind them that even if answers are worded differently, they should still connect to the idea of sharing, not boasting.
