Teacher's Guide

- Review the idea that analogies show **relationships** between words. Model one example by identifying the relationship and applying it to the missing word.
- Encourage students to say the analogy aloud using the pattern "is to" to help them hear the connection more clearly.
- For differentiation, provide a small word bank for students who need extra support. Advanced students can write their own analogies using classroom vocabulary.
- Have partners justify their choices by explaining the relationship they noticed, building critical thinking skills.
- As an engagement activity, let students create analogy cards and trade them with classmates to solve.
- For extension, challenge students to create a three part analogy chain using related words from science or social studies.
