Teacher's Guide

- Remind students that **context clues** come from the whole sentence: actions, feelings, and other details around the bold word all help them decide the meaning.
- Read a few sentences aloud first and have students explain which words or phrases give them hints before they circle their answers.
- For differentiation, allow some students to underline clue words (like "slowly," "a few minutes," "quiet corner") and discuss them with a partner before choosing an answer.
- For extra support, pre-teach a few bold words using simple pictures or quick acting, then have students match those meanings to the sentences.
- To extend learning, invite students to write their own short sentences using one of the bold words correctly, then swap with a partner who must explain the meaning using context clues.
- As an engagement idea, turn it into a "Context Detective" game where students say, "My clue is..." and point out the specific words that helped them solve each vocabulary mystery.
