Text Structure Labels:

1. **Description** - explains what solar power is and how it works.
2. **Compare-Contrast** - compares solar and wind energy, noting similarities and differences.
3. **Cause-Effect** - shows how burning fossil fuels causes pollution and climate change, and how renewable energy reduces it.
4. **Sequence** - explains the steps of how hydroelectric power is made.
5. **Problem-Solution** - presents the problem of high energy costs and the solution of renewable energy sources.

Reflection Question (Sample Answer):

Recognizing text structures helps readers organize information, spot key details faster, and better understand the author's purpose.

Teacher Guide/Notes:

- This worksheet strengthens students' ability to analyze **informational text structures**.
- Encourage students to underline **signal words** (like *first, next, both, different, because, solve*).
- Accept reasonable answers if students can explain their thinking.
- Extension idea: Assign students to write their own short paragraph using one of the five text structures.
