Teacher's Guide

- **Using this worksheet**
 - Review what an analogy is: a comparison that shows how two pairs of words share the same relationship.
 - Model the first example by identifying the relationship type, such as opposites, synonyms, or item to place.
 - Encourage students to read both sides of the analogy aloud to check that the relationship makes sense.
 - Remind students that some analogies may have more than one correct answer if the relationship is still accurate.
- **Differentiation tips**
 - Allow students to work in pairs to discuss tricky items before writing answers.
 - Challenge advanced students to write a second correct answer when possible and explain why it works.
