## Warm Welcome Answer Key

Sample Answers (multiple possible traits accepted):

- **Character Trait:** Kind, friendly, helpful, welcoming.
- **Text Evidence:**
  - "Sarah noticed and smiled at her."
  - "Sarah whispered, 'You can sit next to me if you want.'"
  - "Sarah invited Lina to join her group in a game of soccer."
  - "Sarah said, 'Don't worry—we'll teach you the rules.'"

Reflection Question (Sample Answer):

It is important because showing kindness or friendliness helps others feel comfortable, included, and less nervous.

Teacher Guide/Notes:

- This worksheet builds Grade 4 skills in linking **character traits** to **text evidence**.
- Accept a range of reasonable traits if students support them with strong evidence.
- Encourage students to notice both **actions** and **dialogue** to back up their answers.
- Extension idea: Have students write about a time when they showed the same trait in real life.
