Fable's Message Answer Key

Sample Theme Answer:

Honesty is more valuable than lying to cover up mistakes.

Supporting Examples (may vary):

- 1. The fox lied to the farmer and said he didn't eat the grapes.
- 2. The fox's friends noticed the grape juice on his fur and laughed at his lie, causing him embarrassment.

Teacher Notes:

- Encourage students to see that a theme is a lesson that can apply to many people, not just the fox.
- Common errors: students may write the theme as a single event (e.g., "The fox ate grapes"). Redirect them to the bigger lesson.
- Extension: Have students brainstorm other fables or real-life situations where honesty is important, then share with the class.
