Teacher's Guide

- **Using this worksheet**

- Model how to read a dialogue and identify what tone or idea the missing line should express.
- Remind students that the vocabulary word must fit **naturally** into the final statement.
- Encourage them to read their completed dialogue aloud to test for flow and logic.
- Discuss how dialogue reveals character thinking and problem solving.

- **Differentiation tips**

- Offer vocabulary definitions alongside each prompt for students who need support.
- Allow students to brainstorm possible lines orally before writing.
- Challenge advanced students to write an entire dialogue using three or more vocabulary words.
- Provide sentence starters for English learners.
