### Teacher's Guide

- **Using this worksheet**
  - Review what a multiple meaning word is and show students how context changes meaning.
  - Read one set aloud and model how to look for clues in each sentence.
  - Encourage students to underline context clues that signal meaning.
  - Remind students that one word must fit *both* sentences, even if the meanings differ.
- **Engagement ideas**
  - Turn the matching into a partner challenge where students explain why each word fits both sentences.
  - Play a classroom game where students act out two meanings of a word and classmates guess the word.
  - Have students sort words by part of speech to deepen understanding.
