Sea Turtle Cycle Answer Key

Correct Sequence:

- 1. C. Eggs are laid in the sand by the mother turtle.
- 2. A. Hatchlings crawl out of their eggs and head to the sea.
- 3. E. Young turtles face dangers in the ocean as they grow.
- 4. D. Adult turtles travel long distances across the ocean to survive.
- 5. B. Female sea turtles return to their birthplace to lay eggs.

Teacher Notes:

- This activity builds sequencing skills, which are essential for understanding nonfiction texts and processes.
- Encourage students to reread the passage and underline time-order words.
- Some students may confuse adult turtle travel (D) with returning to lay eggs
 (B). Reinforce that survival comes before reproduction.
- Extension idea: Have students create a diagram or flow chart of the sea turtle life cycle with labeled arrows to visualize the sequence.
