Possible Student Answers (Context-Based Definitions):

Reflection Question (Sample):

- These words build a sense of danger, challenge, and problem-solving.
- They help show Ethan's fear but also his ability to survive.
- They create a mood of tension and determination.

Teacher Guide:

- Remind students to look for context clues such as synonyms, explanations, or cause-and-effect hints in the sentences.
- Accept student definitions that capture the meaning even if not worded exactly like a dictionary.
- Encourage students to underline the words in the passage that gave them hints (e.g., "rising so high," "air grew," "flickering light," "built a lean-to").
