### Teacher's Guide

- **Using this worksheet**
  - Review how analogies show relationships, not just definitions.
  - Encourage students to name the relationship aloud before answering.
- **Differentiation**
  - Support: Provide a word bank with 5 possible answers and let students eliminate mismatches.
  - Challenge: Ask students to explain the relationship type, such as function, cause-effect, or category.
- **Engagement**
  - Let students work in pairs and justify one analogy choice to the class.
  - Turn 3 items into quick "explain your thinking" challenges.
- **Extension**
  - Students create two original academic analogies from current units.
  - Connect to writing by having students use two analogy word pairs correctly in sentences.
