Teacher's Guide

- **Using this worksheet**
 - Encourage students to read all definitions before matching to avoid quick guesses.
 - Model how to eliminate close but incorrect choices by checking for **precision**.
- **Differentiation**
 - Support: Read definitions aloud and discuss key words that signal meaning.
 - Challenge: Ask students to write one original sentence using two matched words correctly.
- **Engagement**
 - Turn the activity into a timed challenge where students explain one tricky match.
 - Have students create hand motions or short explanations for selected words.
- **Extension**
 - Students replace two definitions with their own student-friendly versions without losing accuracy.
 - Connect to content areas by identifying where these words appear in science or social studies texts.
