Precision Paragraph Answer Key

Note: Student responses will vary. A correct response must include a clear paragraph that uses at least four vocabulary words accurately and in context.

Sample response:

The committee should **analyze** how the current schedule affects learning before making changes. They need to **evaluate** data such as attendance and test scores to decide what is **relevant** to student success. Any claims should be supported by **credible** sources, including teacher feedback and school records. The **context** of different grade levels is **significant** because younger and older students have different needs. Finally, the committee must **justify** its decision by explaining why the chosen schedule best supports learning.

Teacher's Guide

- Using this worksheet
 - Review each vocabulary word briefly and discuss how it is commonly used in academic writing.
 - Remind students that accuracy matters more than using many words.
 - Require underlining so vocabulary use is easy to spot and assess.
- Differentiation
 - Support: Allow students to plan by writing one sentence stem for each chosen word before drafting.
 - Support: Reduce the requirement to three words for students who need scaffolding.
 - Challenge: Require five or more vocabulary words and a clear claim supported by reasoning.
 - Challenge: Ask students to replace one word with a precise synonym and explain the change.
