- 1. Maya is nervous/anxious.
 - Clues: She grips the script tightly, avoids eye contact, taps her foot rapidly, and sighs heavily afterward.
- 2. She wants to appear confident to the teacher and other students.

Another option: She may fear that showing nerves will hurt her chances of being chosen for the play.

- 3. The sigh and concern about messing up show she deeply cares about doing well. It matters to her, likely because she values theater or wants the role badly.
- 4. Jordan thinks she looks confident, but readers know from the text that Maya is nervous. This shows her outward calmness hid her true feelings.
- 5. Possible accurate answers:
 - She may feel disappointed but keep trying for future plays, since she clearly cares about theater.
 - She might practice more to improve, showing perseverance.
 - She could lean on Jordan's encouragement to boost her confidence.

Teacher Notes:

- **Skill emphasis:** Students should support inferences with text evidence.
- Look for reasoning: Answers that include both the inference and the specific clue from the story are strongest.
- Extension idea: Have students rewrite the audition scene from Jordan's point of view, highlighting how an outside perspective can miss inner feelings.
