Analysis Answer Lab Answer Key

Responses will vary. Strong answers should include accurate academic vocabulary, clear explanations, and text based evidence.

Sample responses:

1. Mara's motivation appears conflicted because she hesitates before sending the message. This behavior suggests uncertainty and emotional tension. The repeated rewriting of the reply provides evidence that she is unsure about the consequences of responding.
2. The streetlight may symbolize decision making or control. Its flickering reflects Mara's uncertainty, while the changing light represents the pressure to act. This symbol contributes to the scene's significance by reinforcing her internal struggle.
3. The tone of the passage is tense and reflective. Words such as paused, erased, and quickly create a sense of hesitation and urgency. These choices help develop an anxious mood.
4. The final sentence emphasizes the theme of uncertainty. By describing the decision as something that might change its mind, the author highlights how fragile and temporary choices can feel. This contributes to the overall significance of hesitation in the passage.
5. Mara's internal conflict contrasts with her decisive outward movement across the street. While she appears active, her thoughts reveal hesitation. This contrast helps develop the reader's perspective by showing that action does not always mean certainty.
