## **Revolution Ripple Answer Key**

## Sample Cause & Effect Chains (Model Answers):

- Invention of new machines → Faster production → Growth of factories and industrial jobs.
- Abundance of coal and iron → Fueled factories and railways → Expanded transportation and markets.
- 3. **Agricultural improvements**  $\rightarrow$  Fewer farm workers needed  $\rightarrow$  Migration to cities  $\rightarrow$  Urban growth and overcrowding.

## Other Acceptable Chains:

- Factory work → Long hours and unsafe conditions → Labor reforms and eventual worker rights movements.
- Industrial growth → Pollution and sanitation problems → Public health challenges.

## Teacher's Notes:

- Students should show a *logical sequence* (not just random pairings). Encourage them to use arrows or flowchart-style diagrams.
- Emphasize that one cause can lead to **multiple effects** (e.g., machines increased production *and* led to factory expansion).
- Accept answers with slightly different wording if they show clear understanding of relationships.
- Extension idea: Have students connect one Industrial Revolution effect to a modern consequence (e.g., urbanization or climate change).
