Gravity Present (P):

- P Apple falling to the ground.
- P Feather falling on the Moon.
- P Satellite in orbit.
- P Soccer ball on the field (gravity holds it down).
- P Comet's curved path toward the Sun.
- P Book on a desk (gravity keeps it there).
- P Balloon rising (gravity still acts, even if buoyancy opposes it).
- P Meteor falling toward Earth.
- P Ship leaving orbit (needs to overcome gravity).
- P Light bending near a black hole (gravitational lensing).

Gravity Absent (A):

- A Astronaut in microgravity (effectively weightless).
- A Flashlight beam in space (light motion not caused by gravity here).
- A Probe far from massive bodies (negligible gravity).
- A Radio signal traveling between planets (not affected by gravity).
