## Option 1: Gatsby vs. Tom

- Gatsby (Unique): Self-made wealth; driven by dream of Daisy; idealistic and romantic.
- **Both:** Wealthy; compete for Daisy's love; represent excess of the 1920s.
- Tom (Unique): Born into "old money"; arrogant, domineering; unfaithful without shame.

## Option 2: Daisy vs. Myrtle

- Daisy (Unique): From wealthy family; chooses comfort and status over love; outwardly graceful.
- Both: Unhappy in their marriages; caught in destructive relationships with
  Tom; defined by their role in a male-dominated world.
