## Two Circles, Two Worlds Answer Key

### Sample Responses

#### Option 1: Gatsby vs. Tom

- **Gatsby (Unique):** Self-made wealth; driven by dream of Daisy; idealistic and romantic.
- **Both:** Wealthy; compete for Daisy's love; represent excess of the 1920s.
- **Tom (Unique):** Born into "old money"; arrogant, domineering; unfaithful without shame.

#### Option 2: Daisy vs. Myrtle

- **Daisy (Unique):** From wealthy family; chooses comfort and status over love; outwardly graceful.
- **Both:** Unhappy in their marriages; caught in destructive relationships with Tom; defined by their role in a male-dominated world.
- **Myrtle (Unique):** Lower class; seeks escape through affair; desperate for upward mobility.
