Teacher's Guide

Purpose

- Help students in grades 4 to 6 practice identifying key Greek landforms.

Instructional Tips

Engagement Ideas

Extension Activities

- Have students label the three featured landforms on a blank outline map of Europe.
- Let students research one interesting fact about the Peloponnese Peninsula, Mount Olympus, or the Aegean Sea.
