Words with the root "bio": biology, biography, biotic, bio, life, lifelike, biodegradable

Explanation: The root "bio" means *life*. Knowing this helps explain that all these words relate to living things or the study, story, or imitation of life.

Teacher's Guide

- Objective: Help students recognize and apply understanding of Greek and Latin roots to determine word meaning in context.
- Engagement Tip: Before reading, write "bio" on the board and have students brainstorm any words they already know that include it. Then, predict what "bio" might mean before confirming through the passage.

Differentiation:

- Grades 6-7: Provide one highlighted example (e.g., biology) to model identification.
- o Grades 8-10: Ask students to write a short paragraph using a different root (e.g., "geo," "aqua," or "tele") in at least five words.

Extension Ideas:

- Have students highlight the same root in their science or history textbooks.
