# **Daily Root Reflections Answer Key**

## Sample Responses:

• Day 1 Root: Geo (Greek) - means earth.

Example words: geology, geography, geothermal.

Sample sentence: We studied the layers of the earth in our geology class.

Day 2 Root: Therm (Greek) - means heat.

Example words: thermometer, thermal, hypothermia.

Day 3 Root: Aqua (Latin) - means water.

Example words: aquarium, aquatic, aqueduct.

#### Teacher's Guide

- **Objective**: Strengthen vocabulary by developing a personal, reflective connection to **Greek and Latin roots** and their meanings.
- Engagement Tip: Begin each class with a "Root Reveal" moment—introduce a root dramatically or through a quick riddle (e.g., "I mean heat and live inside a thermometer—who am I?").

#### Differentiation:

- Grades 4-5: Offer a short list of sample roots to choose from each day.
- Grades 6-8: Encourage independent exploration students can find roots from textbooks or online dictionaries.

### • Extension Ideas:

- Have students create a Root-of-the-Week poster with visuals and example words.
- Build a classroom "Root Wall" where daily discoveries are added all year long.
- At the end of each week, ask students to combine several learned roots to invent a new word and define it creatively.
