Teacher's Guide

• Engagement Tip: Start with a mini "root relay." Divide the class into teams; call out a prefix and see who can shout out a matching root + suffix to form a real word first.

• Differentiation:

- Grades 4-5: Provide a brief definition list of common prefixes, roots, and suffixes to support recognition.
- Grades 6-7: Challenge students to use each new word in a creative sentence or short paragraph.

Extension Ideas:

- Have students invent one "new" word by combining valid Greek/Latin roots and explain its possible meaning (e.g., aqualume = water light).
- Create a classroom "Word Forge Wall" where students add examples of root-based words they encounter in reading throughout the week.
