(Sample Responses)

- 1. The school could use solar panels instead of electricity from fossil fuels. This reduces carbon dioxide emissions by replacing coal and gas power.
- Solutions include driving electric cars and encouraging public transportation. Both reduce the number of gasoline-powered vehicles releasing carbon dioxide.
- 3. Communities could plant new forests or protect existing ones. More trees absorb carbon dioxide, lowering the amount in the atmosphere.
- Alternatives like solar, wind, and hydropower create energy without burning fossil fuels. They reduce the release of greenhouse gases into the atmosphere.
- A leader could pass laws supporting renewable energy use or limiting deforestation. These programs directly lower greenhouse gas emissions and slow global warming.
