\_\_\_ Families prepare their menorahs and place them near a window for all to see.

\_\_\_ The first candle is lit, along with the helper candle called the *shamash*.

\_\_\_ Families recite special blessings to honor the beginning of Hanukkah.

\_\_\_ Traditional songs like "Maoz Tzur" are sung to celebrate the miracle.

\_\_\_ Delicious foods such as latkes and sufganiyot (jelly doughnuts) are shared.

\_\_\_ Children play dreidel games and win small chocolate coins called *gelt*.

\_\_\_ Each night, another candle is added until all eight lights are glowing brightly.

\_\_\_ On the final night, families reflect on the meaning of courage, faith, and light.
