- 14. They **have** reached the mountain top already.

## **Teacher Notes:**

- Some corrections involve changing the form of "be" ( $am \rightarrow is$ , was  $\rightarrow$  were).
- Others involve switching "has/have" correctly depending on the subject.
- A few require adding the -ing form of the main verb (is play → is playing).
- Point out that sometimes the mistake is **extra or unnecessary** (like #9, where "was cleaned" would mean passive voice, not simple past).
- Extension idea: Have students write **two new "error sentences"** of their own and swap with a partner for correction.
