- 1. **Meaning in own words**: It means that democracy is created by ordinary people, serves them, and must endure.
- Reason for ending: Lincoln wanted to inspire hope and remind listeners that
 the soldiers' sacrifices were for a greater purpose—the survival of
 democracy.
- Connection to Civil War goals: It reflects the Union's fight to preserve the
 nation and ensure freedom and equality, rather than letting it collapse
 under division.
- 4. **Modern significance**: The quote continues to symbolize democratic values, reminding citizens that government should remain accountable to the people, not controlled by a few.
