### Teacher's Guide

## **Differentiation Tips:**

- **Grades 2-3**: Read the story aloud; pause to discuss possible meanings before filling blanks.
- **Grades 4-5**: Have students explain their reasoning for each homograph choice using context clues.
- Grades 6-8: Challenge students to create their own "fill-in" homograph stories using at least six double-meaning words.

## **Engagement Ideas:**

- Turn it into a "Homograph Detective" game: students circle clues that helped them pick each word.
- Use illustrations or gestures to act out both meanings of one chosen homograph.

#### **Extension Activities:**

- Ask students to rewrite the story using the **other meaning** of at least three homographs.
- Create a **Homograph Hunt Wall** in class: students add new words they find in reading that have double meanings.
