Sample Responses

(Accept any grammatically correct and logical answer that uses the correct homonym meaning.)

1. **Duck** - Duck when the ball flies toward your head!
2. **Watch** - Let's watch a funny movie tonight.
3. **Ball** - Everyone wore fancy clothes to the royal ball.
4. **Bark** - I heard the dog bark loudly at the mail carrier.
5. **Bat** - He hit the baseball with a wooden bat.
6. **Ring** - I heard the school bell ring at noon.
7. **Wind** - Please wind the toy car so it will move.
8. **Light** - This box is light enough for me to carry.
9. **Camp** - The scouts camp in the mountains every summer.
10. **Right** - Turn right at the traffic light to reach the store.

Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tip:** For younger students, provide visual cues (e.g., pictures showing both meanings).
- **Engagement Idea:**
 - Turn it into a "Homonym Rewrite Race." Students compete in pairs to create the most creative or funny version of each swapped sentence.
- **Extension Activity:**
 - Challenge students to find three new homonyms not used in the worksheet and write their own "Sentence Switch" examples.
 - Encourage them to share aloud, allowing peers to guess the original and switched meanings.
