Teacher's Guide

• **Skill Focus**: Strengthens awareness of how **homonyms impact clarity** in formal writing-especially in **law**, **science**, **and technical fields**-teaching students to analyze meaning in professional contexts.

• Differentiation Tips:

- For younger or early middle-grade students, simplify passages or define the context first.
- For high school or advanced learners, add real-world excerpts from legal or scientific texts to analyze.
- **Engagement Idea:** Host a "Word Court." Assign roles (lawyer, judge, witness) and debate which meaning fits best based on context.

Extension Activity:

- Have students find examples of ambiguous wording in real documents (school rules, user manuals, etc.) and rewrite them for clarity.
