## Word Double-Take Answer Key

### Sample Responses

(Accept other logical answers that correctly show two meanings.)

1. **Watch** - I wear a watch on my wrist. / Let's watch a movie tonight.
2. **Park** - We will park the car near the entrance. / The kids ran through the park after school.
3. **Leaves** - The wind blew the colorful leaves away. / She leaves for school every morning at seven.
4. **Right** - You were right about the answer. / Turn right at the corner.
5. **Duck** - A duck swam across the pond. / Duck down so you don't hit your head!
6. **Point** - Don't point at people; it's rude. / The main point of the story is kindness.
7. **Tire** - The car has a flat tire. / Long walks tire me out.
8. **Light** - The lamp gives off soft light. / This box is light enough to carry.
9. **Bat** - A bat flew out of the cave. / He hit the ball with a bat.
10. **Seal** - The envelope had a wax seal. / We saw a seal clapping at the zoo.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For younger or emerging writers, provide sentence starters or word banks.
  - For advanced learners, challenge them to include both meanings of the word in *one creative sentence* (e.g., "I saw a bat fly by as I grabbed my baseball bat").
- **Extension Activity:** Have students draw a cartoon for each word, showing both meanings side by side.
