Teacher's Guide

- Read one passage aloud and pause after each potential homophone to discuss meaning.

- Discuss how writers use homophones to create humor, wordplay, or vivid imagery.

Differentiation Tips:

- **Grades 2-4:** Provide a short homophone reference list before reading.
