### Teacher's Guide

- **Focus Skill:** This activity teaches students to use **context clues** to distinguish between **homophones**, emphasizing meaning over sound.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For younger or struggling learners, read sentences aloud and emphasize tone shifts that hint at correct meanings.
  - For advanced students, challenge them to write a short paragraph using at least three homophone pairs correctly.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Turn this into a "Context Detective Game"-students explain what clue in each sentence helped them decide.
  - Let students act out a few sentences to show how context changes the meaning of homophones.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Have students create riddles using homophones ("What word sounds like 'flour' but grows in a garden?").
  - Encourage learners to write two different sentences using each word from a single pair to reinforce meaning contrast.
