Teacher's Guide

- **Focus Skill:** Students learn how **homophones** behave in **collocations**-phrases or word pairings that sound natural in English-improving fluency and word choice accuracy.
- **Differentiation Tips:**

 - Challenge advanced students to **create new collocations** for each homophone pair (e.g., *bear hug*, *bare truth*).
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn it into a class "Homophone Match Game" using index cards-students find their phrase partner.
 - Use examples from songs or books to show real-life use of homophone collocations.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students write a short paragraph or dialogue using at least five correct collocations from the list.
 - Encourage learners to keep a "Homophone Phrase Journal" where they collect funny or confusing examples they encounter.
