

Tracking Information Like an LLM

This activity helps you practice remembering details from earlier in a passage, just like Large Language Models (LLMs) do when predicting text.

Instructions - Read the passage carefully. Pay attention to **names**, **places**, and **objects** mentioned early. Fill in the blanks with the correct details. Answer the comprehension questions that follow.

On a chilly Saturday morning, **Maya**, her cousin **Lucas**, and their friend **Priya** went to the city park.

Maya carried a basket of sandwiches, while Lucas brought a soccer ball. Priya carried a sketchbook to draw the trees and flowers.

After they ate their sandwiches on a bench, Lucas suggested they play a quick game of soccer. Maya agreed, but Priya preferred to stay behind and sketch the fountain.
