Ready To Make Answer Key

Answers will vary. A correct materials list should show:

- **accuracy** based on the chosen task,
- **specific detail**, such as types of paper, sizes of pots, or digital devices,
- **completeness**, including every item needed to successfully begin the task.

Example acceptable points (sample task: plant a seed):

- small pot, potting soil, packet of seeds, water cup, plastic tray, plant label, measuring spoon for soil.

Teacher's Guide

- Use this worksheet to help students strengthen **planning skills** that support strong how-to and process writing.
- Emphasize that good writers think ahead about **materials, tools, and resources** before beginning any procedure.
- For differentiation:
 - Provide picture cards of common tools and materials for younger or emerging writers.
 - Allow students who need support to choose from a provided bank instead of generating the list independently.
 - Encourage advanced students to include **justifications** for certain materials or list alternatives.
- For engagement:
 - Let students compare lists with a partner to see which items match and which differ.
 - Allow groups to build a real or model version of their chosen task using their lists.
- For extension:
 - Have students write the full how-to after completing their list.
 - Ask students to categorize items as tools, ingredients, equipment, or supplies.
