## Task 1 - Identify Paraphrased Sections

**Model Answer**: The entire AI response is a paraphrase of Dr. Morris's ideas.

**The sentence** "Clothing companies that rely on fast fashion encourage constant buying and discarding" directly paraphrases Morris's line about fashion becoming a "disposable commodity" and the "endless cycle of consumption."

The second sentence ("The fashion sector produces vast amounts of waste and contributes about ten percent of the world's carbon emissions") paraphrases the original statistic about textile production accounting for roughly 10% of global carbon emissions.

The third sentence ("Cheap prices make shoppers overlook the serious environmental impact...") clearly rephrases Morris's statement that "The industry's low prices mask a high environmental cost."

**Explanation**: Although the Al reworded the content, it preserved the same structure, examples, and data. Because the ideas remain identical to Dr. Morris's original work, each section must be cited as a paraphrase.

**Teaching Note**: Emphasize to students that changing words does *not* erase the need for citation. Paraphrasing is an act of translation, not authorship.

## Task 2 - Write Proper In-Text Citations

APA In-Text Citation: (Morris, 2023)

MLA In-Text Citation: (Morris 23)

**Explanation**: In both APA and MLA, only the original author and year (or page number, if known) appear in the in-text citation. Even though ChatGPT generated the paraphrase, the *ideas* belong to Morris. The AI itself should be acknowledged elsewhere, either in an author's note or a transparency statement about use of digital tools, but not within the formal citation of the idea.

**Teaching Note**: Remind students that citation follows *intellectual ownership*. The Al rephrased existing human knowledge-it did not originate it.
