## Voices And Values Answer Key

Answers will vary; the following examples show logical reasoning for teachers to assess understanding.

### 1. Freedom of speech should have limits.

- *Agree:* Speech that spreads hate or violence can harm others.
- *Disagree:* Limiting speech can silence important voices and opinions.

### 2. Equal access to education.

- *Agree:* Education gives everyone a fair chance to succeed and understand their rights.
- *Disagree:* Some countries may need to focus resources elsewhere first.

### 3. Lawbreakers and rights.

- *Agree:* Serious crimes can mean temporary limits on rights for safety.
- *Disagree:* Human rights belong to all people, even those who made mistakes.

### 4. Free speech on social media.

- *Agree:* People sometimes use it to spread false or harmful messages.
- *Disagree:* It allows people worldwide to share ideas and fight injustice.

### 5. Citizens and responsibility.

- *Agree:* Everyone must speak up and act fairly to protect rights.
- *Disagree:* Governments have more power and resources to enforce laws.

#### • Differentiation Tips:

- Pair students for a "mini-debate" format before writing their answers.
- Offer sentence starters such as "I believe this because..." or "This matters since..."

- **Engagement Idea:** Use current examples from news or history to connect debates to real-world issues.
