

## Fair Play Fixes Answer Key

### Sample Reasoning

1. Encourage everyone to listen equally and suggest taking turns sharing ideas so all voices are heard.
2. Sit with the new student, be friendly, and remind others that teasing someone's accent is disrespectful.
3. Advocate for equal opportunities by asking teachers or coaches to make the team open to everyone.
4. Politely let the teacher know some students also need support or offer to help classmates.
5. Report or block the comment, show support for the person targeted, and remind others about kindness online.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For younger or emerging writers, allow verbal responses or sentence stems ("I would help by...").
  - For advanced students, encourage adding reasoning or real-world examples that connect to global human rights.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Conduct a "Fairness Circle" where students discuss how they've handled similar situations.
  - Use role-playing to help students practice respectful problem-solving.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Have students write a reflection titled "*Why Fairness Starts With Me.*"
  - Create a classroom "Equality Pledge" where students contribute one promise to make their school more inclusive.
