Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For students who struggle, remind them that **I** does the action, while **me** receives it.
 - Encourage students to say each sentence aloud to "hear" which pronoun sounds right.
- **Engagement Idea:**
 - Pair students for a "Formal Rewrite Race." Each partner reads a sentence aloud informally, and the other rewrites it correctly in formal language.
- **Extension Activity:**
 - Have students write three casual sentences of their own using incorrect pronouns, then swap papers with a partner to correct and explain each choice.
