Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Reinforces correct use of **I** (subject pronoun) and **me** (object pronoun) through sentence-level analysis.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For emerging learners, review subject vs. object pronouns with visuals (e.g., "I do it" vs. "He helps me").
 - For advanced learners, add sentences with compound subjects or objects (e.g., "My sister and I baked cookies").
- **Engagement Idea:**
 - Turn the activity into a "Pronoun Detective Game." Students use colored pencils (blue for underline, red for circle) and "solve the pronoun mystery."
- **Extension Activity:**
 - Have students write three new sentences using **I** and **me** correctly, then exchange papers to check each other's work as "proofreaders."
