## Definition to Example Answer Key

### 1 - A (Cause/Effect)

- Signal words: "because, as a result." Explains reason and outcome.

### 2 - E (Description)

- Sensory details about the polar bear's habitat and traits.

### 3 - B (Compare/Contrast)

- Shows similarities (both string instruments) and differences (frets, number of strings).

### 4 - D (Problem/Solution)

- Problem: overcrowded cafeteria. Solution: more lunch periods.

### 5 - C (Chronological)

- Uses sequence words "first, then, finally."

### Teacher Notes

- Reinforce **signal words**: underline or highlight them once matched.
- Extension: ask students to create their own definition/example "cards" for practice or as a classroom game.
