## Definition to Idiom Answer Key

1. Throw in the towel - Stop trying.
2. Beat around the bush - Avoid saying something directly.
3. See eye to eye - Agree with someone.
4. Let the cat out of the bag - Reveal a secret too soon.
5. Let your hair down - Relax and enjoy.
6. Cut to the chase - Get to the point.
7. Pull your weight - Work hard/put in effort.
8. Drag your feet - Waste time/delay action.
9. Kill two birds with one stone - Do two things at once.
10. Add fuel to the fire - Make a bad situation worse.

### Teacher Notes:

- This worksheet flips the usual process: instead of matching idioms to meanings, students **recall the idiom from a definition**.
- Encourage students to say the idiom aloud to practice fluency.
- Extension idea: Have students **create their own clue-style definitions** for new idioms and challenge classmates to solve them.
