Sayings in Scenes Answer Key

1. break the ice - **A** (Teacher tells a joke to ease tension).
2. bite the bullet - **E** (Woman chooses to face something painful).
3. on cloud nine - **G** (Girl is extremely happy after winning).
4. raining cats and dogs - **D** (Heavy rainfall image).
5. cost an arm and a leg - **H** (Luxury car with shocking price).
6. let the cat out of the bag - **C** (Child spoils birthday surprise).
7. hit the nail on the head - **B** (Player's comment is exactly right).
8. hold your horses - **J** (Horse image matches idiom literally).
9. the last straw - **I** (Extra stress after repeated failures).
10. keep your chin up - **F** (Encouragement after disappointment).
