Windy Outcome Answer Key

Cause-and-Effect Relationship (Expected):

- **Cause (Frame 1):** Mr. Harris opens the heavy wooden door.
- **Effect (Frame 2):** A strong breeze enters, scattering papers and refreshing the class.

Possible Frame Sentences:

- Frame 1: *Mr. Harris pushes the door open.*
- Frame 2: *The breeze blows papers and cools the classroom.*

Teacher Notes:

- Students may illustrate additional details (students fanning themselves, papers flying, students laughing). This is acceptable as long as the drawings clearly capture the **cause** (door opened) and the **effect** (breeze enters with consequences).
- Emphasize that cause-and-effect relationships often involve **an action** followed by **a reaction**.
- Encourage students to match their sentences to text evidence rather than inventing unrelated events.
