## Scenes of Change Answer Key

### Expected "Before Frame" Details:

- Quiet, nearly empty square
- Fountain gurgling softly
- A few shopkeepers setting up
- Birds hopping on cobblestones
- Smell of bread from bakery

### Expected "After Frame" Details:

- Busy square filled with people
- Stalls with fruits, spices, fabrics
- Children running and playing
- Musicians near fountain
- Smells of roasted meat and sweet cakes
- Loud, lively atmosphere

### Sample Student Explanation:

- "The square started out quiet with only a few shopkeepers and birds. Later, it became crowded with people, music, and food smells. The change shows how the town came alive by midday."

### Teacher Notes:

- Look for drawings that show contrast between **calm and busy** atmospheres.
- Encourage students to use sensory details (sounds, smells, sights) in their labels or explanations.
- Artistic accuracy is less important than showing **clear differences supported by the passage**.
