## Two Sides Of A Race Answer Key

### Emma's Perspective (Runner):

- At the **starting line** with trembling legs
- Focused on the **finish line** ahead
- Crowd noise blurred into background hum
- Feeling nervous but determined

### Lily's Perspective (Spectator/Friend):
